Our Mission

Leverage community resources to increase student achievement, create opportunities and build support for public education.

Our Focus Areas

Our programs, partnerships and advocacy efforts support three focus areas:

- “At-Risk” Students, primarily from low income homes, need help overcoming economic, language and learning barriers that impede learning and school success.
- Increasingly important competencies in **science and math** need to be nurtured to increase student interest and achievement. And, **innovative technologies** must be deployed to better engage all students.
- Excellent teachers are the single largest school-based factor that determines student success.

Our Initiatives

- Impact on Education annual programs such as Classroom Mini-Grants and Impact Awards provide ongoing support to teachers, and the Opportunity Fund and Crayons to Calculators annually create opportunities for and provide resources to “at risk” students.
- Impact on Education promotes innovation by partnering with community organizations to extend resources and by incubating promising projects and technologies.

Impact on Education celebrated our 25th anniversary and received wonderful support from the community. With Boulder Valley School District's help and 30 sponsoring organizations, school buses sported colorful decals throughout the 2008-09 year to promote a contest that engaged students of all ages in creating short animation features. While kids thought it was all fun, custom contest software created by Kerpoof (now part of Disney) used education themes and fulfilled BVSD literacy and technology education standards.

Additionally, we continued support of annual programs – Classroom Mini-Grants, Impact Awards, Opportunity Fund, Crayons to Calculators – and incubated a number of innovative pilot programs. The educators who partner with us to extend educational excellence, increase equity and promote innovation in BVSD inspire us. Annual Programs Create Opportunities for At Risk Students

Nearly 5,000 BVSD students participate in the federal meal-assistance program, a common measure of family poverty. With dramatic increases in unemployment and home foreclosures, many more students need support. These students, their teachers and schools require extra resources to help ensure academic success and graduation.

Opportunity Fund

Created in 2004 to reduce the economic barriers that negatively affect the educational experiences of students from economically challenged homes, the Opportunity Fund covers education-related expenses for students whose families cannot afford them. These expenses include field trips, class fees, musical instrument rentals, bus passes, yearbooks, athletic equipment, class planners, student/class pictures, graduation caps and gowns.



Especially true for younger students, field trips and hands-on activities help them “connect the dots” and discover interests and abilities. Research shows that in middle and high school, students are highly motivated by interests and activities. Many of them keep up with their learning because it is required for participation in sports and clubs. Without such a “hook” – especially for kids lack-

ing a culture of education in their homes – a large number of kids aren’t likely to learn, succeed and graduate.

We thank Flatirons Elementary, Horizons K-8, Platt Middle School and Southern Hills Middle School who opted out of the Opportunity Fund in the 2008-09 school year, allowing more funds to go to higher-needs schools.

An elementary school principal wrote:

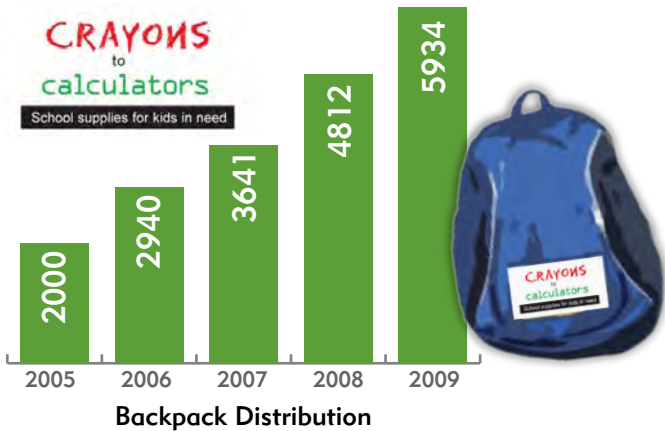
“One of our fifth-grade students had not returned her outdoor education paperwork. She was sad and confided in a friend that because her mom could not afford the cost of the trip she didn’t even bring the paperwork home. The Opportunity Fund allowed her to have the same experience as her classmates without worrying about how this would affect her family’s basic needs at home.”

CRAYONS TO CALCULATORS

In August, more than 5,900 students were provided with backpacks of school supplies through Crayons to Calculators, a collaboration between Impact on Education, the “I Have a Dream”® Foundation of Boulder County, Sister Carmen Community Center, Foothills United Way, the St. Vrain Education Foundation and FISH of Broomfield, and with support from Boulder Valley and St. Vrain school districts. Promoting Innovation By Incubating Promising Projects

In addition to our annual programs, Impact on Education incubates promising research-based programs and interventions. We measure program impact, leverage new technologies, expand student interest and achievement in science and math, and seek to mitigate the achievement gap. Finally, we work with BVSD to scale the most effective strategies.



Open World Learning (OWL)

This after-school and summer program at Creekside Elementary leverages the school's computer lab into powerful education opportunities that include mentorship, leadership development, peer teaching and student collaboration.

Girls At the Museum Exploring Science (GAMES)

The Girls At the Museum Exploring Science partnership with the CU Museum of Natural History provides after-school programming for girls from high-needs elementary schools. Participants discover and explore diverse areas of science through hands-on activities with CU women scientists.

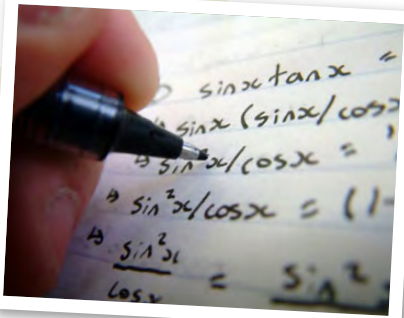


Amgen Life Sciences

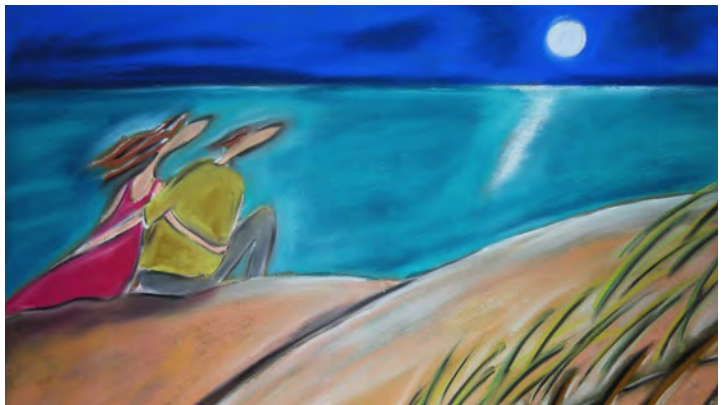


Algebra 1 Interventions

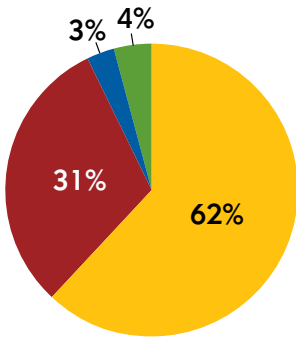
Centaurus and Monarch high schools are piloting alternative instructional interventions with freshmen who need additional academic support in Algebra.

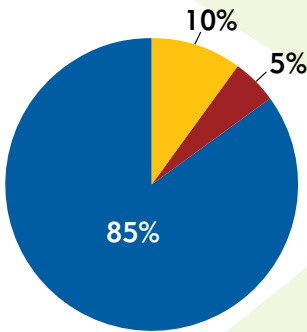


Sources and Uses of Funds



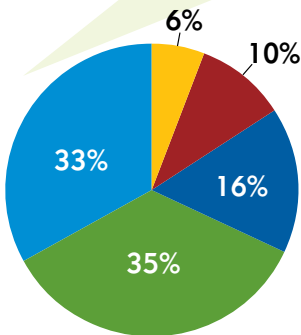

Hundreds of volunteers supported Impact on Education this year! Our volunteers helped in countless ways, from reading and scoring Classroom Mini-Grants to serving on program and event committees. School ambassadors from each BVSD school serve as a conduit of information between Impact on Education and their individual school communities.



Did you Know?

- A recent study by “Colorado Succeeds” estimated that the cost to our communities for each H.S. dropout hits \$2.3 million when factoring decreased personal income potential and the cost of associated crimes!
- Colorado ranks 30th in HS graduation rates; only 74% of students graduate H.S. (56% of African-American students and 44% of Hispanic students), costing us \$3.4 billion dollars a year in lost earnings potential.
- The average college graduate earned 45% more than H.S. grad in 1970, today the differential exceeds 75%. And, a high school dropout makes even less.
- Colorado is ranked 43rd in funding K-12, and 49th in funding Higher Education.
- While Colorado is among the top 3 states in college-educated citizens, it ranks among the lowest in college attainment: For every 100 Colorado ninth graders, only 19 graduate with an Associates Degree in 3 years, or a Bachelor’s Degree in 6 years!
- Boulder Valley School District does better, graduating nearly 90% of its students with the vast majority going on to college. However, only 65% of BVSD Hispanic students graduate and just 22% attend college. And, BVSD has a 40 point achievement gap between whites and Hispanic student performance.

By working together, we can do better!
